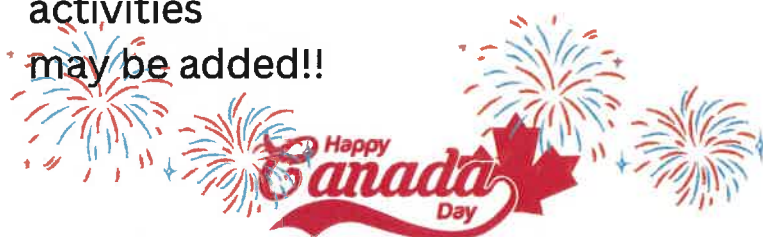

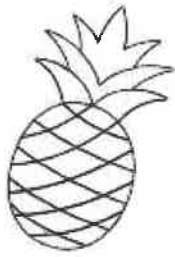

We, at Ted Laurier Place join together to extend our sincere condolences to the family and friends of our departed residents.

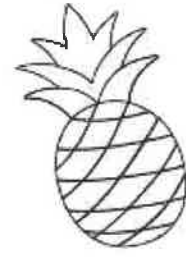
